Welcome to the Arts Department for the Fall of 2020!

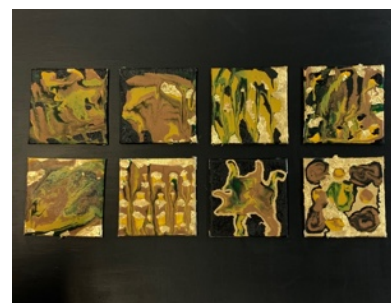

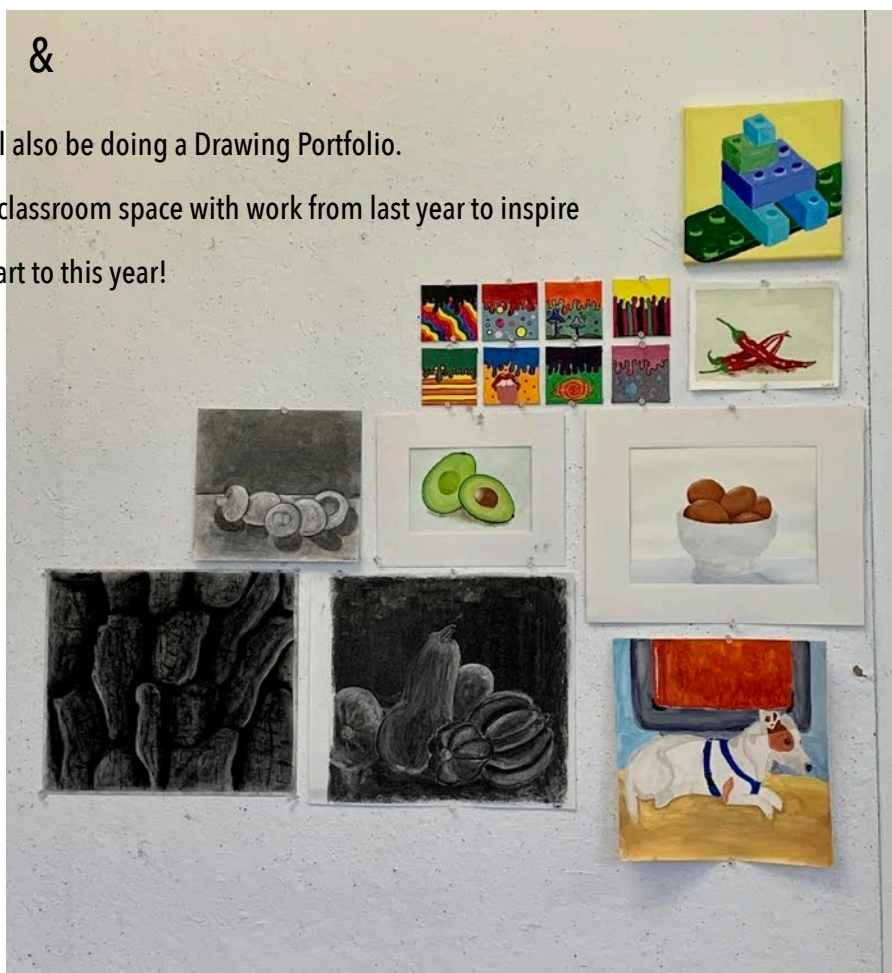


We have two AP Art students this year: **Charlotte Davis-Hup** (above), a senior who will be doing her Drawing Portfolio
